 - Time, money, health, energy
 - Will you be cruising retired? On sabbatical? Dividing your time?

 - Learn to sail

- 4. Buy the right boat for YOU
 - Best to purchase 1-2 years before planned departure
 - 6-12 months boat shopping, 6-12 months refitting, 6-12 months living aboard and sailing
 - Be sure to consider overall cost of ownership

- 5. Keep your expectations realistic
 - Expect chores and boat maintenance to take extra time
 - Simplified life and less stress and more time together
 - Adventures, exploration, time for personal projects
 - Excellent opportunities to learn new skills
- 6. Develop an ethos of safety
 - Learn to balance speed, comfort, and safety
 - Establish and post a workable watch schedule and standing orders
 - Seasickness: follow protocol on www.mahina.com/seminars scroll down to HANDOUTS
 - Study and understand collision avoidance
 - Conduct twice daily boat checks of sails, rigging, engine, and bilge
 - Get out of the cockpit for deck checks; circuit of the deck every watch
- 7. Start learning NOW
 - Make mastering sailing your goal
 - Aim for ease of handling by all crew members
 - Work toward competent and confident singlehanding
 - Start learning weather patterns and getting familiar with forecasting options
 - Learn proper navigation, practice using apps, and keep a log it's a legal requirement
- 8. Start downsizing NOW
 - Liveaboard 6+ months before departing to adjust
 - Decide together what comes or goes and where to stow
 - Put one project away before starting the next
- 9. Get healthy and fit NOW
 - Maintain a fitness habit or start one now
